




## **Education Expansion**






## **Universal Primary Education**








## **Educational Progress Reduces Teenage Birth Rates**

#### Benefits of secondary education for health in 6 LMIC cohorts

#### Ethiopia: Young Lives

Secondary education benefits

- Alcohol 68% lower risk
- Poor psychosocial skills 74% lower risk

#### India: Young Lives

Secondary education benefits

- Undernutrition 51% lower risk
- Low wellbeing 54% lower risk
- Poor general health 77% lower risk
- Smoking 90% lower risk
- Alcohol 70% lower risk
- Injuries 79% lower risk
- Poor psychosocial skills 64% lower risk

#### Peru: Young Lives

Secondary education benefits

• Smoking 70% lower risk

#### CAPS cohort South Africa

Secondary education benefits

- Poor general health 42% lower risk
- Chronic condition/disability 46% lower risk
- Smoking 36% lower risk
- Teenage pregnancy (<18y) 64% lower risk</li>
- Early sex 48% lower risk

#### Kagera cohort Tanzania

Secondary education benefits

- Poor general health 65% lower risk
- Illness in past month 39% lower risk

#### Cebu cohort Philippines

Secondary education benefits

- Psychological distress 54% lower risk
- Smoking 64% lower risk
- Early marriage 70% lower risk
- Early sex 87% lower risk
- Pregnancy before 18 years 63% lower risk
- Unprotected sex 53% lower risk






## **Varying Legal Frameworks**

Legal pluralism permits religious, traditional and customary law or practice to trump national legislation:

- Reservations to international conventions
- Exceptions to national legal frameworks based on customary/religious/traditional law



## **Developmentally Informed Legal Frameworks**

- Take greater account of evolving adolescent cognitive and emotional capacities
- Similar cognitive abilities to adults in emotionally-neutral situations
- Vulnerability to peer influence during stressful situations

- Given knowledge, and with appropriate safeguards, adolescents are competent to make effective decisions about almost all important matters in their lives, including their health
- The exceptions: adolescents need legal and policy safeguards and support for decisions made in contexts where heightened emotion affects the choices
  - o Substance use
  - o Sex
- The capacity for adolescent learning should be exploited through graduated legal and policy frameworks
  - o Driving
  - o Youth justice
